



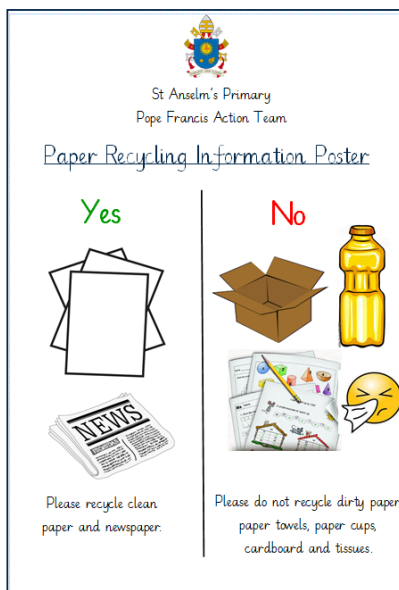
## Pope Francis Action Team

Minutes: 16th November 2023

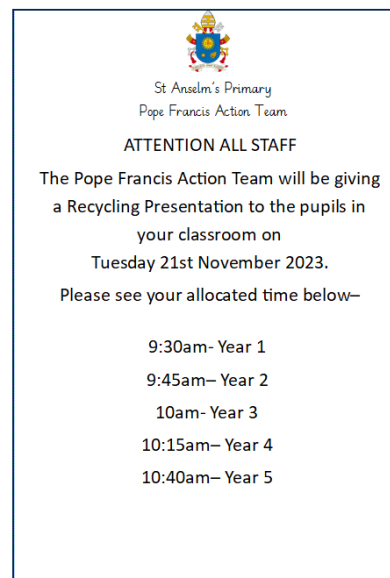
