- Pupil voice at St. Anselm's is strong and relevant across the school in terms of their teaching and learning, assessment and knowledge.

- Pupils can confidently explain their learning in class and make realistic links to their daily lives at home, school and in the wider community.
- Children practise the Gospel Virtues and principles of Catholic Social Teaching in the way they live their lives.
- The majority of pupils lead prayer in class or for the whole school.

Actions

- Support some pupils who feel they cannot link Scripture to their everyday lives with explaining meaning of reading from the Bible and aiding their reflection time.
