


Speech and Language Message of the Week

"it's a plane, the plane is white, the plane is flying"




OP TIPS FOR SPOKEN LANGUAGE

QUESTIONING HIERARCHY

Changing our questioning gives children:

- a framework to guide their thinking and answers
- opportunities to answer questions that are at their level







If a child can't think

of the word try...

Descriptive cueing

"you catch it at the airport, it flies you to another country..."



Add a word to what the child said
